





Slovenian Book Agency: funding opportunities for foreign publishers

GRANTS FOR THE TRANSLATION AND PUBLICATION OF WORKS BY SLOVENIAN AUTHORS

The Slovenian Book Agency's main form of international promotion is the co-financing of translations of Slovenian literature into foreign languages. Eligible works include adult fiction, children's and young adult fiction, essayistic and critical works on culture and the humanities, plays, graphic novels and comics. Applicants must be legal persons (e.g. publishing houses, theatres). The available grants cover up to 100% of translation costs, to a maximum of 10.000€. Grants cannot be awarded retroactively.

In light of Slovenia's role as Guest of Honour at the Frankfurt Book Fair 2023, a special tender for **translations into German** has been

introduced. This grant can cover up to 50% of all costs connected with a book's publication and promotion (excluding license fees), to a maximum of 11.000€ for first publications, or 50% of all costs (excluding license fees), to a maximum of 3.000€ for reprints, where eligible costs are printing, typesetting, cover design and corrections.

GRANTS FOR PRINTING COSTS

Foreign publishers can apply for contributions towards the costs of printing translations of Slovenian authors. The funding can cover up to 70% of printing costs, to a maximum of 3.000€. Applicants must be legal persons (e.g. publishing houses, theatres). Grants cannot be awarded retroactively.

SLOVENIA - GUEST OF HONOUR AT THE FRANKFURT BOOK FAIR 2023

In 2022 and 2023 publishers from EU countries can apply for a fixed sum of 5.398,48€ towards the costs of translating, editing, printing and publishing Slovenian works in foreign languages.

Travel grants are also available for Slovene authors, translators, editors or rights agents, who have been invited to literary or industry events abroad. An invitation and the program for the event must be enclosed with the application. Successful applicants will be awarded a fixed sum of 747,67€ for events in Europe or 1.343,65€ for events outside Europe. There is one call per year, which covers trips throughout the year.

Ana is an illustrator of poetry, prose, fairy tales and picture books, who has hitherto illustrated over a hundred monographs, mostly for children.

She is best known for her illustrations of Anica in the popular book series by Desa Muck. She also illustrates school textbooks and manuals, periodicals for children and youth as well as drawing cartoons for daily newspapers. She resides and works in Ljubljana.

KARMEN JENIČ (1982)

Karmen is a Slovenian writer who received the Svetlobnica Literary Award for 2018 for her debut *Orientiraj se po soncu* (*Go after the Sun*). As a primary school teacher she regularly encounters young people with their joys, curiosity, ground-breaking questions and problems, as well as their parents, her colleagues and the challenges of the school system.

A brilliant story about schoolchildren Jan, Jon, Tjaž and Tay, teacher Rebeka, principal Robi, caretaker Nace and last, but not the least, school social worker Rabi Rabuni who occasionally gives lessons in mathematics, sports, technology and - especially - in attentive listening, love and mercy. The Rabi is actually God who, in answer to the prayer by one of the pupils, took on the human form again and descended to Earth in order to show his children how classrooms and school hallways can become places of sincerity and joy.



The book also received the Rožanc Award, which is given annually to the most outstanding essayist in Slovenia.

The title *Pejsaži (Landscapes)* refers to a thread connecting all essays in which the author deals with various topics: 'The word landscape usually brings to mind a segment of rural or urban panorama. In a way, we could say that there is at least a fragment of landscape in every essay.' In this, his second book of essays, the author, in his own words, 'attempted to integrate his emotional and spiritual experience into each essay, transcending theoretical discourses, including Slovenian smallness, ideological frictions and stereotypes in terms of individual thinking.'


his scientific research are Greek tragedy, the modern attitude towards ancient poetry and Ontology of Poetry. His published works include six collections of poetry, three books of essays on the spiritual aspects of contemporary Slovenian culture, as well as several translations from Greek, Roman and Renaissance literature. In 2012 he received the Sovre Prize for his translation of Seneca's Oedipus. In 2021 he received the Prešeren Fund Award, the highest national recognition for artistic achievements.

The poems collected in the Arie Antiche (Ancient Arias) spring from those remote areas where all human elements - body and soul, now and forever, desire and fulfillment, love and loneliness - come together and become one. Although these spheres may be unknown to us and invisible to the naked eye, due to its fragmented perception, they are a constant object of our longing and amount to a great beyond opening up within all things.

This is how the author explained the title of his book: "Since my childhood I have been surrounded by old music which my father liked to listen to and sing along. Hence the title Arie Antiche, i.e. antique arias, most of which originate from the Baroque period. For me, this music has always evoked intimacy, simplicity, sincerity and refined sensuality. These arias kept ringing in my ears, bones and soul, and I have always desired to write something that would have a similar effect."

IVAN ESENKO (1957)

Ivan is a writer, photographer, conservationist and beekeeper. Since his youth he has been a devoted naturalist, focusing especially on the study of fauna and its relevance for garden ecology. On these topics he has written a number of popular and professional articles. His published work includes several books on garden ecology. He is also a keen photographer, specializing in animal portraiture.

It would be difficult to find a country so closely associated with beekeeping as Slovenia. It is marked with brilliant names from the beekeeping world and with a Carniolan bee and almost every Slovenian village adorns at least one beehive. There are about 10,000 beekeepers in Slovenia, which puts our 2-millions-nation in the very top.

Beekeeping means following bees, adapting to the lawfulness of their lives and turning this ability of coexistence to ourselves. In this encyclopaedic book on bees and beekeeping, Ivan Esenko presents the bee family and the life in the hive, describes the Carniolan bee, Slovene beehives, the breeding of queens, beesfriendly gardens, products related to beekeeping and many other attractions.

The monograph is equipped with more than 500 photographs and it is intended for all beekeers and all people who respect the bees.
